1	Having <u>at least participation in the inter-college /inter-zonal /district / school competition</u> in sports and games as recognized by the AIU (<i>Association of Indian Universities</i>) / IOA (<i>Indian Olympic Association</i>) / SGFI (<i>School games Federation of India</i>) / Government of India.	50%	45%
OR 2	The candidate should have passed <u>Bachelor's Degree in Physical Education (BPE)</u>	45%	40%
OR 3	The candidate should have passed <u>Bachelor's Degree in any discipline</u> and studied <u>Physical Education as compulsory /elective subject.</u>	45%	40%
OR 4	Having <u>participated in National /Inter-University /State</u> Competitions or <u>secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter-college / inter-zonal / district / school competition</u> in Sports and Games as recognized by Respective Federation / AIU / IOA / SGFI / Government of India	45%	40%
OR 5	The candidate should have passed <u>Bachelor's Degree</u> with <u>participation in International Competitions</u>	Pass	Pass
OR 6	At least <u>three years of teaching experience</u> (<i>for deputed in-service candidates i.e. trained Physical Education Teachers/ Coaches</i>).	45%	40%
Candidates who has appeared for the Qualifying Examination in the academic year 2019-2020 and qualified the B.P.Ed CET 2020 successfully, they will become eligible for admission to B.P.Ed. 2020 only if they produce Marks Memo/ Degree Certificate of the Qualifying Examination and fulfil the eligibility criteria mentioned above while filling in the Admission Form in the Centralized Admission Process (CAP) 2020.			
Candidates from Outside Maharashtra Universities will be considered as Open Category candidates and criteria applicable to Open category candidates will be applicable to them			
The percentage of marks shall be calculated by rounding off to two places after decimal. This round off will be applicable to the Percentage above the Minimum Percentage of Marks required for qualifying examination mentioned above [<i>For Ex. - 49.50% on wards till 49.99% cannot be round of to 50% in case of Open, EWS and OMS Candidates and 44.50% onwards till 44.99% cannot be round off to 45% in case of Backward Class candidates.</i>]*
