Discussion with the alumni.</li></ol> <p>The prospective plan is divided into two phases. In the first phase, what we are going to do in the next five years in the areas of Academic, Research, Extension, Student Support, Infrastructure and Governance, while in the second phase, what exactly needs to be done every year is detailed.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>● Dr. Deepak Shendkar asked for detailed information about which courses the college is going to start in the next five years.
