IQAC Initiative 2020-2021

1. Academic and administrative audit:

For the first time since the establishment of the college, an academic and administrative audit was conducted due to the initiative of IQAC. The academic audit was conducted in December 2020 by IQAC Cluster India. Immediate and appropriate action was taken on the suggestions and recommendations given by this audit committee.

2. Prepare Policy and Procedures:

In the academic year 2020-2021, policies and procedures were written for various components of the college with the initiative of IQAC. Detailed policies and procedures for the components of Consultancy, Curriculum Delivery, Valuation, Extension Wing, Mentoring, Practice Teaching, Research, Sports, Student Welfare and Technology were written by various committees. These policies and procedures were discussed and finalized at the IQAC meeting and approved by the College Development Committee (CDC). The finalized policies and procedures are displayed on the college's website.

3. International conference LEAP:

As planned in the college's prospective plan the First International Conference was organized on March 24 & 25, 2021. The conference was based on the theme 'Lead to Excellence in Athletic Performance' (LEAP). The International Conference consisted of a total of five sessions and a total of 277 participants (Indian and Foreign) had registered and attended the conference. Various research scholars also presented their research to the participants and were published in the journal.

4. Started Using all Social Media Platforms:

IQAC took the initiative to make effective use of social media to disseminate information about various activities or courses run in the college to the stakeholders and the society. Telegram channel, Instagram page, Facebook page and YouTube channel were started and displayed information of various activities and courses of the college on social media from time to time. For this, an outsourced company was appointed for the whole year.

5. Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct for Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff in the College was fixed to maintain the quality and professionalism of the College. For that a committee of three faculties was formed. The code of conduct created by the committee was discussed at the IQAC meeting and finalized. The final draft of



the Code of Conduct was presented in the meeting which was discussed in detail. This Code of Conduct includes Code of Conduct for Principal, Responsibilities of the Head of Department, Code of Conduct for the Teacher, Code of Conduct for Non-Teaching Staff and Publication of Research Papers and Books and Participation in Research Projects, Seminars, These are divided into different sections.

6. Seminar on online Physical Education

The Corona epidemic caused lockdowns all over India. So schools started working online. During the first Lockdown there was a lot of confusion among various teachers about how to conduct physical education activities online. To guide physical education teachers in Maharashtra, the college organized an online seminar on Online Physical Education in April 2020. The seminar was broadcasted via. Facebook Live. Along with this a guideline book for Online Physical Education based on the ideas and suggestions put forth by the experts in this seminar was prepared and disseminated to the PE teachers through various social media platforms. It is also published on the college's website.

7. Expert talk on NEP2020 for PE stakeholder

In 2020, India's National Education Policy was announced. The college organized a lecture to disseminate information on various provisions of the new education policy to various people working in the field of physical education and sports. The lecture was given by Dr. Sanjeev Sonawane, Dean, Savitribai Phule Pune University. This online lecture was conducted through Google Meet and was attended by more than 100 participants - PE Teachers, experts and enthusiasts in Physical Education and Sports.

8. Faculty development program

The Faculty Development Program on various subjects and topics were organized through IQAC initiative in the academic year 2020-21 to bring academic discussion among the college professors and to make all the professors aware of the modern trends in various subjects. Faculty development programs were organized on the following topics:

- Workshop on "From Teaching to learning"
- Teaching style in Physical Education
- Workshop on Use of Google classroom
- Voice Culture
- Research writing
- Group discussion on NEP and school reality

9. International Workshop on Spectrum of Teaching style

An International Workshop on 'Spectrum of Teaching Style' was organized on April 1, 2021 to make the various teaching styles of physical education known to all and to be implemented in our regular teaching process. International Expert Prof. Sara Ashworth, USA. guided the faculty and other invited experts (total 22 members) during this workshop.

10. Teacher's Diary:

All the professors in the college have been preparing teaching plans for their respective subjects. But from this academic year onwards, with the initiative of IQAC, it was decided that the professors should maintain the teaching diary of their subject. The format was shared to all the professors by IQAC and maintenance of records was confirmed.

11. Prepare template for documentation:

To make the documentation in the college more systematic, IQAC prepared templates related to activity report, activity attendance, teacher diary, teaching plan, research publication and communicated with all of the faculty members.

12. Started Special program for Students:

A special program named STRIVE (Students - Teaching, Respect, Integrity, Value, Equality) is designed with the objective of developing universal values in student teachers, developing the skills required for student teachers to become self-reliant and cultivating various hobbies. This special program is implemented every Saturday, this program is being implemented through the Student Council. These special programs include lectures on Career Guidance and Entrepreneurship, guidance on self study courses, Hobby Club, discussions with physical education teachers.

13. Planning of Students Induction program:

The student induction program was planned by IQAC. The induction program was conducted for one week. The course included online campus visit, Introduction to curriculum, introduction to various college programs, team building activities. For this a group of 10 students was formed and for that group one teacher and two student council members were appointed as mentors.

14. Organise reflection on Teaching, Extension and Research:

An activity was organized based on Teaching, Extension and Research in the previous academic year. Through this, the teachers made peer presentations regarding the various teaching methods used during teaching, evaluation tools, technology, various programs organized throughout the year and research publications.

15. Organise Webinar on Exercise Science:

The online webinar was organized through Google Meet on July 25, 2021 to help the general public understand the **Science of Exercise**. About 60 people participated in this webinar

16. Green Audit:

IQAC took the initiative and decided to conduct a green audit. For this, the audit is being done through IQAC Cluster India.



17. Social Activity

Diwali Thanksgiving

Under this social activity the CACPE Student Council contacted the NGO -Eklavya Arogya Nyasa. The council provided sweets and clothes on the occasion of Diwali Festival which were collected from the generous college students and staff. Along with this various games and physical activities of those students have been conducted by the students of the college every evening for one hour since March 2020 and are still ongoing.
