1	Finalising Policy and Procedures	A total of 10 policies and procedures including Curriculum Delivery, Evaluation, Research, Sports, Technology, Mentoring, Practice Teaching, Extension, Consultancy and Student Welfare have been prepared and uploaded on the College website after approval of IQAC.
2	Finalising code of conduct for teaching and non teaching faculty	A three-member committee was set up to prepare a code of conduct for teachers and non-teaching staff in the college. After the committee submitted its report, it was presented to the IQAC committee and approved by IQAC committee.
3	Discussion on Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) and Follow up Actions	The Academic and Administrative Audit Report and the Follow-up Action Plan were presented to the IQAC Committee. It was discussed and the next road map was decided.
4	Discussion on Feedback and Result Analysis	The results of final year BPEd and MPEd students were analyzed and IQAC members expressed satisfaction. Feedback on the overall performance of the college was also taken and presented before the committee. It was stated on behalf of the principal that the instructions given by the students regarding hygiene would be acted upon and its modus operandi was fixed.
5	Discussion on Starting Research Journal	Dr. Mahesh Deshpande presented the action plan of the research journal to be started by the college before the committee. It was discussed and the intention was to publish the first edition in June.
6	Discussion on Proposed new Add on course	Geriatric Fitness Trainer Course will be started in the academic year 2020 21. Dr. Shraddha Naik informed all the members about the course and the work of preparing the syllabus is underway through the committee.
