	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Dr. Deepak Shendkar suggested that efforts should be made to maintain proper records of the informal mentoring taking place in the college.</li> <li>• Dr. Ranjit Chitale suggested that students facing issues such as attendance, internal marks, or misbehavior should be provided separate mentoring, and proper records of such mentoring should be maintained.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• As suggested by Dr. Ranjit Chitale, it was decided that students with special needs will be provided mentoring from time to time, and proper records of such mentoring will be maintained.</li> </ul>
